Ord that Josh Elrod James Cornback Cornelius Phillips Sherr Gilles & James Jones Esquire or any three just sworn view and mark out the roads nearest and best way for a road from the Court House to the Camp river at the most convenient place on a direction to Danville and make report

On the motion of Francis Dean satisfactory proof being made to the Ct 318 the Court is of opinion he is entitled to 100 acres of land under the act of 1801 for settling and improving the vacant lands agreeable to location
