ing to me from the Estate of my deceased Father

of Kentucky or from the Estate of my deceased  
Mother Nancy Colyear of said County & State  
and my said Attorney is also hereby authorized to  
bring Suit or Suits as he may think proper for the  
recovery of the same or to compromise the same  
in such way as he may think best and to give such  
Receipts in my name as may be necessary hereby  
ratifying and confirming All the acts of my said  
Attorney may do in pursuance of this power the same  
as if I was present & done the same myself
