This Deed of Conveyance, made and entered into this the 24 day of June, 1918 between Sam F. Parker and Marguerite S. Parker, his wife of Somerset, Ky. but now temporarily residing in Honolulu, T.H. Party of the first part and F.P. Curtis,

A.W.Cain, and E.T.Lee, Trustees of the First Baptist Church, of Somerset Ky., party of the second part, Witnesseth: that said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars in hand paid, and the further consideration that the party of the first part shall have the right to connect a sewer to the sewer system of said church for the benefit of and to serve the residence now on the remainder of the lot yet unsold, from which the parcel hereinafter described is taken, do hereby sell and convey to the party of the second part, their successors or assigns, the following described parcel of ground, lying in the city of Somerset, Ky. and bounded as follows: Beginning at a point in the north line of what is known as the S.E. Parker lot, which point is also the south west corner of the present church lot; thence with the line of said S.E. Parker, which is a continuation of the south line of said church lot Westward 15 feet to a point in said S.E. Parker line; thence a line parallel with the rear line of said Church lot, northward 60 feet to a point on the line of what was formerly the G. Sallee lot, now owned by the party of the second part; thence with said line and parallel with first line herein, eastward, 15 feet to a point in said line which is also the northwest corner of the present church lot; thence with line of same southward 60 feet to the beginning. This boundary is intended to convey and does convey a parcel of land 15 X 60 feet immediately in the rear of and adjoining to present church lot, the full width of same running back 15 feet, so as to constitute an addition of 15 feet to the depth of the present church lot, for the purpose of extending the church building 15 feet. Being a portion of same conveyed to Sam F. Parker, Grantor herein by Joe C. , and Nannie Parker on the 22nd day of September 1911, which deed is recorded in Deed Book 69 page 555, Pulaski County Court Clerk's office, Ky.
